TRADE PROGRAMME

As a Trade Apprentice, you'll combine practical on-site training and college learning as you become a fully qualified Bricklayer or Site Carpenter.

Location

The structure of our Trade Apprenticeship Programmes differ depending on location. For more specific information on the England, Scotland and Wales apprenticeships please see page 8.

Role Description

Bricklayer

Bricklayer is a core function within the construction sector, particularly the housebuilding sector.

A bricklayer's day-to-day role involves laying bricks, blocks, and other types of building components in mortar to construct and repair walls, foundations, partitions, arches, and other structures.

Site Carpenter

Site Carpenters work with building materials (most often wood) to create and install building components. This typically involves shaping and cutting materials, installing finished materials like partitions, doors, staircases, window frames, mouldings, timber floor coverings and erecting structural components such as floor joists and roofs.



COMMERCIAL & TECHNICAL PROGRAMME

Our apprenticeship programme (Level 3) will equip you with the skills and qualifications needed for a long and exciting career in our Commercial or Technical Departments.

Starting each September, the programme combines on and off-the-job training. You'll learn the technical elements of the role alongside industry-leading education.

Commercial - Quantity Surveying & Buying

Estimators, Quantity Surveyors and Material Buyers have one objective: deliver the best quality homes, at the best possible cost. As part of the team, you'll use your creativity and commercial flair to help us choose which sites to buy and develop on and manage the supply of materials and labour for sites.

Technical - Engineering & Design

As an Engineer or Architectural Assistant and get involved in all aspects of housing design and innovation; all of them with unique problems to solve. You'll use your technical skills to help prepare the design programme, respond to site queries and ensure that drawings align with the approved planning scheme.

You can specialise in any of the following:

- Quantity surveying
- Buying
- Engineering

Entry Requirements

- 5 GCSEs (grade C or above or grade 4-9), including Maths and English
- Able to deal equally effectively with numbers and a wide range of people
- Commercially astute
- Full of energy, initiative and commitment







APPRENTICESHIPS IN ENGLAND

Intermediate Trade Apprenticeship

Our Trade Apprenticeships in England last 18 months and are delivered through a residential programme with our partner colleges, Stephenson College in Coalville, Leicestershire and York College, York; earning your Intermediate Apprenticeship 6 months faster than you would in a conventional programme.

Trade Apprentices attend 10 sets of one-week blocks of training over 18 months, beginning with three consecutive residential weeks. During this time you will practice and perfect the skills required to work on real-world projects on-site. Returning home each weekend with all your accommodation, subsistence and travel paid.

This programme finishes with an End Point Assessment, where you will earn your Intermediate Apprenticeship Level 2 qualification and have your trade skills certified.

Advanced Trade Apprenticeship

Advanced Trade Apprenticeships involve a further year of college study and on-site training.

Following an End Point Assessment, you will receive your Advanced Apprenticeship qualification.







APPRENTICESHIPS IN SCOTLAND & WALES

SCOTLAND Trade Modern Apprenticeship

Our Trade Modern Apprenticeships in Scotland last four years and during this apprenticeship you will achieve your SCQF Level 6 and SVQ Level 6 qualifications. Typically, this is delivered as a block release programme with 18 weeks spent at college in the first year and 10 weeks in the second year, where you will learn and practice your skills; followed by two years in the workplace where you will have the opportunity to put this into practice.

The programme finishes with a skills test. Some Apprentices will have the option to study for their SCQF Level 7 Advanced Craft Certificate in year 3.

WALES Advanced Trade Apprenticeship

Our Advanced Trade Apprenticeship in Wales lasts three or four years and combine college learning with practical on-site training equipping you with the skills to complete two job related projects, three multi-choice tests and two professional discussions to achieve your Level 3 Construction Qualification and Advanced Apprenticeship.





HOW TO APPLY

1. Applications open

Applications open in Februry or March each year during Apprenticeships Week.

Please note that, due to the high levels of interest we receive, some locations fill their vacancies early so you are advised to apply as soon as possible.

2. Apply online

Search for 'apprenticeship' and apply for your chosen programme, using the QR Code below. If your application meets our criteria, you will be redirected to a prerecorded video interview where you will be asked a series of brief interview questions.

3. Open day and interview

England & Wales: If you are successful you will be invited to attend an open day at a centralised location. The day will include a short interview and presentation from the course team, providing details on the programme and a short interview.

Scotland: If you are successful you will be invited to attend a final interview with a Director from your local office.

4. Job offer

The successful applicants will receive their job offer from the hiring manager.

5. Start your job

Depending on location, the start date of your cohort will vary.
