Our Degree Apprenticeship Programme

5.5—6 years

Programme Start: September (university in January)

Bespoke to Barratt Redrow, we offer four Degree Apprenticeship opportunities (Construction, Quantity Surveying, Technical or Real Estate).

The apprenticeship combines gaining experience in your fulltime in role, with part-time university study and professional development training.

Programme Structure

You will complete four block weeks per year conducted by <u>Sheffield Hallam</u> University.

The learning will cover various modules relating to your chosen area and will contribute to you gaining a 'Cert HE' (excluding Real Estate) and BSc (Hons) qualification.

As part of the apprenticeship framework, you will participate in off-the-job learning which will relate to your job role and university studies.







Tell me about the recruitment process and eligibility.

The recruitment process starts in February, with employment from September (or earlier if agreed). Apprenticeship study begins the following January. You'll complete a video interview, assessment centre, and university application. If successful, you'll undergo eligibility checks, including skills and knowledge reviews and a discussion with a Work-Based Learning Coach.

Experience isn't required—just enthusiasm to learn, work in a diverse environment, and a passion for people and customers.

What happens at university? What extra work is required?

During block weeks, you'll attend lectures, complete activities and assignments, and share experiences with peers. You'll also prepare and deliver presentations. The programme combines in-person study at Sheffield Hallam University (with nearby hotel accommodation) and online learning. Assignments maybe completed outside of your block-week, so self-motivation is essential.

You'll need to set your study schedule, undertake wider reading, and ensure coursework is submitted on time.

What support will I receive and how much will the degree cost me?

Within your division, a personal mentor will support you through quarterly reviews, discussing your progress at university and in your role. Sheffield Hallam University provides a Course Leader and Work-Based Learning Coach to track your progress and address any additional support needs. You'll also have access to support through the university, our Health and Wellbeing offer, and peer support, including a buddy when you join.

The course is fully funded, saving you approximately £27,000 compared to a traditional full-time degree.



How to apply

1. Apply online followed by a video interview

Get your online application under way by clicking the link below, and don't forget to attach your CV. If successful, you'll be invited to participate in a video interview, where you'll be asked about your key skills, commercial awareness and motivations. <u>Tips here.</u>

2. Assessment centre

Assessment centres will take place from April onwards and will include a short pre-prepared presentation and interview with a Director from your local office.

3. University application

If successful at the video interview stage, you'll complete a university application to check your eligibility against the entry criteria.

4. Job offer and start

Successful applicants will receive their offers from May onwards. We'll also help you complete the remainder of your university eligibility activities, which include:

- A self-assessment of your knowledge, skills and behaviour
- A functional skills review
- A chat with a 'Work-Based Learning Coach'
